

# FAQ'S – MYNETBALL LADDER



## Where can I find the ladder on MyNetball?

Go to the BNA website ([www.bundaberg.qld.netball.com.au](http://www.bundaberg.qld.netball.com.au)). Select 'competitions' > 'ladder' > select 'standard view'. Change the 'grade' to the division that you want to view & select the green GO button.

## Where can I find out the points we got for each round?

Select 'competitions' > 'ladder' > select 'points per round'. Change the 'grade' to the division that you want to view & select the green GO button.

## What do all the columns mean?

W stands for wins

L stands for losses

D stands for draws

Pts stands for the total points for the season to date

% stands for the percentage of goals for divided by goals against

## What does the red A mean?

The red A means that an adjustment has been made to the points for that team. If you click on the red A it will bring up the ladder adjustment window that relates to that team with the explanation as to what the adjustment was for.

## Why do some divisions have adjustments made & others don't??

Adjustments are made for a number of reasons. Here are a few:

- Teams are moved into different divisions & the whole division points are reset
- Players take the court & they aren't registered
- Players from a lower division play up & there aren't enough original players from that team so the game is deemed a forfeit

There will always be a note made explaining the adjustment

## On the 'points per round' view, why are some teams highlighted & others aren't?

The highlighted teams represent the top 4 teams in the division & these are the teams that will be moving through to finals.

## How do I know that the points on the MyNetball system are not wrong?

The MyNetball ladder is checked against the manual calculations on a regular basis by BNA's Registrar to make sure that the information is correct.
